

SLI Fellowship and Aid Opportunities:

Application Deadline: March 21, 2008
Awards will be announced (via email) by April 5.

Open to all applicants:

General SUMMER INSTITUTE TUITION SCHOLARSHIPS (for all languages)

A number of full and partial tuition scholarships will be available. Sources include funding from the Croatian Scholarship fund, Center for Russian and East European Studies Program and Summer Language Institute scholarships. Applicants should demonstrate high academic quality. Proof of financial need is not required; however, you may mention special circumstances at the end of your statement of purpose.

Social Science Research Council (SSRC) Fellowships for advanced Russian

SSRC fellowship funds are available on a competitive basis for all students studying Russian at the advanced or fourth-year level. No separate application is required.

Open to Graduate Students only:

FOREIGN LANGUAGE AREA STUDIES FELLOWSHIPS (provided through Pitt's Center for Russian and East European Studies). Open to students working toward a graduate or professional degree in any field. The target language must relate to the student's research and/or professional goals. The FLAS awards will include tuition and \$2,500 stipend. All current graduate students and entering graduate students who apply for a scholarship will automatically be considered for this award. Separate application form is NOT required. Students of first and second-Russian are not eligible for FLAS funding due to U.S. Department of Education regulations. For other languages, first-year students are eligible for consideration. Open to US citizens and permanent residents only.
